01	07.06.23	Received a complaint through email sent by one Dipankar Das alleging that his 6 years old daughter was suffering from a disability in her right leg, for which he attended orthopedic OPD of G.B. hospital on 18.04.2022 . The doctors of hospital advised him to consult with paediatric orthopedic surgeons, but they did not refer his child to a higher centre and thereafter he returned home without any treatment. In the month of May, 2022 his daughter got hurt in her right leg and thereafter he consulted with a paediatric orthopedic department of Rainbow Children Hospital of Bengaluru and treated her there. He submitted a medical reimbursement bill, but his bill has not been processed and, therefore, by sending this	

email complaint he has sought relief to the Commission.

The bundle of facts as stated in the complaint petition, prima facie, does not come under the purview of a human rights violation to invoke jurisdiction of this Commission. It seems to be a dispute over medical re-imburement which has to be decided by the appropriate authority in accordance with law applicable to the petitioner / complainant.

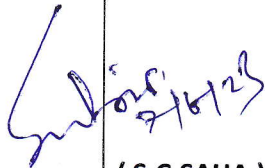
The bundle of facts stated by the complainant does not reflect that his minor child was ever admitted in the GBP Hospital either on 18.04.2022 or on 02.05.2022. His child suffered injury while playing on 02.05.2022 and he treated her at Bengaluru Hospital.

Be that as it may, it has to be decided by the appropriate authority in accordance with law and the Commission cannot

entertain it. The complainant, if so advised, may approach the appropriate authority / Forum for the relief he has sought.

The complaint accordingly stands disposed in-limine.
