## ORDER DATED 25.10.2023

Received a complaint through email sent by one Sauptik Bhattacharjee, alleging inter aliq, that he is a student of  $9^{th}$  standard of Sri Krishna Mission School, Agartala and he was supposed to participate in a cultural programme and was requested to play the role of 'Mahishashur' in some programme as was approved by the teachers including the Director of the School, but it was opposed by one of the teacher, Mr. Niranjan Bhattacharjee. While he was supposed to perform in the programme, the teacher Mr. Niranjan Bhattacharjee created unnecessary chaos and tension and pushed him out of the stage and as a result he suffered fracture injury in the left leg knee and other injuries in his right hand. The incident occurred in the presence of teachers including the Director and the audience. He was shifted to G.B. Hospital for treatment. He has enclosed the copies of prescriptions as well as copies of photographs in support of his contention and made a request to inquire into the incident and to take necessary steps.

The incident, as alleged, has occurred in a function of a privately managed School, where no public servant or public authority is involved. The Human Rights Commission's jurisdiction extends to an incident of violation of human rights or abatement of such violation by a public servant or public authority only. Since the commission do not have any jurisdiction to inquire into the matter where no public servant or public authority is involved, we cannot

initiate an inquiry or take action in the matter.

The instant complaint accordingly stands disposed in limine.
