		commercial vehicles (3-wheelers and 4 wheelers) most	
		unusually and without any rhyme or reason. It is causing	
		immense hardship for the common air passengers who

In a democracy, every organization / authority has to work according to law. If Airport authority has authorized some private organizations of outside Tripura to collect entry charges, there must be some rules and regulations approved by the Statutory Authority having power of making such rules. Collection of fees / charges at the whims of any private organization violates human rights of the common passengers of the State and hence, we think it appropriate to direct the Director, MBB Airport Authority, Agartala to submit a detailed report in respect of the allegation made in the news item alongwith copies of documents, if any, before the Commission on or before the next date.
