to the Medical Superintendent, AGMC & GBP Hospital for final post-mortem report. But that has not been done even after repeated reminders and requisition sent by the IG, Prisons.

We have passed a detailed order on 18.07.2023 in this respect. A copy of the order was sent to SP, Sepahijala District, SP, West Tripura District, OC, Bishalgarh PS, OC, NCC PS as well as Inspector General of Prisons.

It is quite surprising to know that neither SP, West
Tripura District nor SP, Sepahijala District felt it
necessary even to give a response to the Commission as
to what happened to visceras of the foreign national and
why the report has not been sent to the Medical
Superintendent, AGMC & GBP Hospital.

To our utter dismay and surprise, we got a letter dated 27.07.2023, written by OC, Bishalgarh PS, directly addressed to the Chairperson, THRC stating that the visceras were collected by the I.O. of the case Contd...P/3...

ASI Pradip Natta of Bishalgarh PS but due to some unavoidable circumstances, the visceras were not sent to the SFSL for analysis and report.

At the outset, we would like to note that any of the order any communication pursuant Commission must be addressed to the Secretary of the Commission and the Chairperson as well as Members such any about addressed directly be cannot communication which should be noted by the senior officers and should be followed in future.

From the letter OC, Bishalgarh PS, it is quite evident that ASI Pradip Natta was sitting over the U.D. case and did not perform his duty, but no action has been initiated against him. OC, Bishalgarh PS was supposed to have supervision over this sort of matters and he has also failed to discharge his duty, even did not state in the letter as to under what unavoidable circumstances visceras were not sent to the SFSL.

Therefore, OC, Bishalgarh PS as well as ASI Pradip Natta of Bishalgarh PS should submit their

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response in writing as to why action should not be proposed against them for negligence in their duty in connection with such an important issue of inquiry about a foreign national, within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of issue of this order.

We further direct that OC, Bishalgarh PS should take immediate step to have the visceras examined by and to send the report to the Medical **SFSL** Superintendent, AGMC & GBP Hospital for final postmortem report and shall arrange submission of the final PM report to the Commission which shall be personal responsibility.
