The allegation of the complainant does not come under the purview of human rights violation as contemplated under the provisions of the Protection of Human Rights Act. If somebody tries to encroach upon their land, they may approach appropriate civil Court for protection of their rights, if they are so advised.

As against illegal trespass, so far alleged by the complainant, in case of such apprehension, they may approach the Executive Magistrate as well as the law enforcing agencies to protect their rights. The Commission since has no jurisdiction cannot make any recommendation, but the complainant if so desires, may place the copy of this order to the competent authorities while lawfully approaching for any relief. A copy of this order may be given to the complainant.

A copy may also be sent to the District Magistrate & Collector, West Tripura and the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Sadar.
