

01	27/05/2024	<p>Attention of the Commission is drawn to a news item with heading “সরকারি দপ্তরে হয়রানির শিকার নবতিপর এক বৃদ্ধা” published in a daily newspaper namely Tripura Darpan dated 27/5/2024, wherein, it is reported that one Smt. Arati Sarkar aged about 90(ninety) years of Narsingarh Panchayat under Bamutia R.D. Block was residing with her youngest son namely Sri Sajal Sarkar.</p> <p>After the expiry of Sajal Sarkar, she could not stay with her daughter-in-law for her ill treatment and started residing with her eldest son Shyamal Sarkar. Her name was recorded in the ration card of her youngest son, Sajal Sarkar. She approached to the Narsingarh Panchayat for deleting her name from the ration card of her youngest son and also for correction of RoR, so that she could get her ration commodities regularly. But the RoR is not corrected till date and as a result, she is unable to draw her ration commodities due to negligence on the part of Narsingarh Panchayat.</p> <p>The allegation as reported against Narsingarh Panchayat seems to be serious as it amounts to violation of human rights.</p> <p>Considering the allegations reported in the news item, the Commission considers it appropriate to issue notice to the BDO, Bamutia R.D. Block to inquire into the matter and to take appropriate steps in respect of supply of ration commodities to the victim Smt. Arati Sarkar and to submit a written response to the Commission within 3(three) weeks.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Pg 1of (2)</p>
