



South Tripura stating that she is a regular employee in the office of Director for Welfare of SCs under Tripura State Government and presently she is posted in the office of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Belonia. One Mr. Anup Das (Group-D) S/O Mr. Dhananjoy Das of Gabtali School Tilla, PS-P.R. Bari, Dist. South Tripura is her colleague. Mr. Anup Das took loan from Tripura Gramin Bank, Belonia Branch and the complainant is the guarantor of loan of Mr. Anup Das. Mr. Das is not recovering his loan for the last three /four months and as a result the bank locked the account of the complainant lying in Tripura Gramin Bank, Belonia Branch.</p> <p>In the result she is unable to withdraw money from her account. The bank may recover lone from Mr. Das and instead of that locked the account of the complainant and so she prays before the Commission to have an order directing the bank to unlock her bank account so that she can</p>	


withdraw money and survive with her family members.


Prima facie it appears to be a civil dispute between the bank and complainant which does not come under the purview of violation of human rights.

The complainant, if so advised, may approach appropriate legal forum seeking redressal. With this observation the complaint stands disposed in limine.
