

01	11/07/2024	<p>Receipt a complaint from one Smt. Mukta Rani Das (Malakar), W/o Sri Dilip Malakar of Tongibari, Dharmanagar, North Tripura, wherein, she has alleged that she has lodged a complaint at Dharmanagar Women Police Station vide FIR No. 0018, dated 29/06/2024 and accordingly a criminal case was registered against the accused persons vide Case/No. 0018/2024, U/s 447/325/506/34 of IPC. Thereafter, the accused persons named in the complaint attacked her, her husband and minor son and beaten them seriously in their house. They have kept her house under lock and key and as a result she with her are family living in a rented house. Her allegation is that even after reporting the incident to the police, no action has been taken against her elder bother-in-law because he is most influential and powerful both in money and muscle.</p> <p>The complainant is present before us and we have orally examined her. Her only allegation against the police is that they are not acting properly and not taking action against the accused persons under the influence of her elder brother-in-law.</p>	


Considering the allegation, the Commission thought it appropriate to call for a report from the Superintendent of Police, North Tripura about the allegations made by the complainant, before taking formal cognizance and initiating inquiry about inaction on the part of police.
