



01	15/07/2024	<p>Attention of the Commission is drawn to certain news items published in different daily newspapers of Tripura including one Tripura Bhabishwat, dated 13/07/2024, wherein, it is alleged that a person named Sujit Dey of East Gonki under Khowai Police Station was called at Ambassa Police Station saying to interrogate him and thereafter, the Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Nirupam Datta has mercilessly beaten Sujit Dey and as a result, he was admitted at Kulai Hospital, Ambassa for treatment.</p> <p>Corporal punishment after detaining a person by police is strictly prohibited by law. No one made a complaint before the Commission. However, such an incident as alleged and reported in the news item is bound to blame the noble policing of the state. Perhaps the superior authority of the police has already taken note of the news item. Since the report if true violates human right, the Commission before taking formal cognizance likes to see a report from the Director General of Police (DGP), Tripura on the news item.</p> <p>Send a copy of this order along with the newspaper cutting of the daily newspaper Tripura Bhabishwat, dated 13/07/2024 to the DGP, Tripura to have an inquiry on the matter and to submit a report before the next date of hearing.</p> <p>List it after 3(three) weeks.</p> <p>Fix on... 08/08/2024</p> <p> (Justice S.
