



01	15/07/2024	<p>Received a complaint through e-mail sent by one Dipak Kumar addressed to the Director General of Police (DGP), Tripura and numerous others including this Commission.</p> <p>The jurisdiction of the Commission extends to initiate inquiry in respect of violation of human rights by a public servant or authority as defined under the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993.</p> <p>The complainant stated in his e-mail that after declaration of panchayat elections, law & order has been violated by culprits and sought for legal action against the violators.</p> <p>Since the complaint is addressed to the DGP, Tripura and many others and a copy of it is marked to the Commission and further there is no specific case of violation of human rights by a public servant or authority, the Commission cannot initiate an inquiry on such bald allegations.</p> <p>Hence, the Commission cannot take cognizance in the matter and accordingly it is disposed in limine.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> (Justice S.
