01	12/08/2024	<p>Attention of the Commission is drawn to news item published in different daily newspapers of Tripura, dated 11/08/2024 and 12/08/2024, wherein, it is reported that a Government Post Graduate Teacher namely Abhijit Dey of Poultry Road, Udaipur was forcefully taken to the house of one Shankar Karmakar on an allegation of sending bad message to his minor daughter over mobile phone and thereafter, Abhijit Dey was mercilessly beaten up by Shankar Karmakar and his associates and when his wife went to save him, she was also beaten up. Thereafter, Shankar Karmakar handed over the seriously injured Abhijit Dey to the R.K. Pur Police Station, Udaipur and police produced Abhijit Dey before the Court where he vomited blood and thereafter, he was taken to the District Hospital and from there he was referred to GBP Hospital, Agartala, where he succumbed to the injuries he received.</p> <p>The bundle of allegations so far reported in the news items speak of death of a person while he was in custody and that of physical assault on the allegation of sending bad message, which the Commission likes to know the actual incident occurred and therefore, before taking formal cognizance likes to receive a report from the Superintendent of Police, Gomoti District, through the Director General of Police, Tripura and on receipt of such report further steps will be taken by the Commission.</p> <p>Issue a notice along with a copy of few paper cuttings to the Superintendent of Police, Gomoti District for submitting report within 4(four) weeks.</p> <p>Fix it on <u>12.09.2024</u>.....</p> <p>(Justice S.
