


(Complaint by Smt. Shiqli Paul against traffic control of Tripura.).

02	12/08/2024	<p>The Superintendent of Police (Traffic) has submitted a report in writing, pursuant to the Commission's order dated 10/07/2024.</p> <p>It is reported that the complainant did not mention the registration number or any other relevant information to identify the auto rickshaw which has violated the provisions of law by carrying passengers beyond its capacity. It is also reported that often, the auto drivers violate traffic rules by carrying excessive passengers in Agartala city and traffic police is taking action against such violators. As per the record of the traffic unit, during last 6(six) months, 1654 cases of violations were detected and an amount of Rs. 3,50,900/- was recovered as fine. Further, the traffic unit has issued notices against the violators with seizure and suspension of driving licenses in accordance with rule. The traffic police have also prepared an action plan to generate awareness among the drivers so that the right of the passengers is maintained.</p> <p>Considering the report, the Commission thinks it appropriate to close the matter at this stage since appropriate action has been taken by the Tripura Traffic Police Department.</p> <p>Accordingly, the inquiry initiated is closed.</p> <p>Copy of this order may be sent to the Superintendent of Police (Traffic), Tripura, Agartala and to the complainant.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> (Justice S.
