02	16/08/2024	<p>The complainant Sri Rajib Debbarma is present in person. He has been examined on oath and his statement has been recorded. He has submitted several documents in his name, which show that he established and continued a stall in Govt. land at Karbook market in a slope part near unemployed shed. He had an electric connection and telephone connection in his name. The Sub-Zonal Development Officer (SZDO), Karbook, TTAADC issued a trade license in his name on 03/09/2021. While he was smoothly doing his business for about a year, his mother suddenly fallen ill and for her treatment he went away from Karbook for few months and at that time one Ramani Mohan Tripura of Karbook occupied his shop and started business of restaurant changing the name of the shop.</p> <p>After return to Karbook, the complainant submitted a complaint before the SDM, Karbook and SDM on 15/07/2023 after hearing him and Ramanai Mohan, passed an order, but even after repeated requests that order was also not given effect and Ramani Mohan continued doing business in his shed, whereas, he is deprived of his own shop.</p> <p>He has alleged that his right to life has been illegally taken away by the SDM, Karbook, SDO, PWD(R&B) and SZDO, Karbook, TTAADC.</p>	

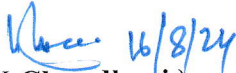
