Taking into consideration all the facts and materials on record, the Commission by order dated 14/06/2024 asked the complainants to submit specific cases of discrimination/violation of right to equality in respect of similarly situated people that some people had been regularly promoted subject to the ultimate decision of the Apex Court and some promoted on ad-hoc basis in the same service where the complainants were also serving.

In response to that query, the complainants submitted a representation on 08/08/2024, wherein, they admitted that they did not find any specific case to submit before the Commission, but they pointed out certain allegations in different paragraphs. Out of it, the Commission's attention is drawn to Para VI, which is required to be answered by the State Government in the appropriate department.

The Commission, therefore, directs that a copy of the representation made by the Complainants on 08/08/2024 be sent to the Secretary GA (P&T) Department, Govt. of Tripura to give response to the allegations made therein, especially in respect of Para VI of the said representation.
