



Under such circumstances, the Commission carefully examined the contents of the complaint wherein it is alleged that the complainant made a prayer before the Kalyanpur Children Development Project Officer claiming old age allowance and he has submitted all documents but his prayer was not forwarded to BDO even after repeated requests.
