(Complaint by Miss. Pranita Banerjee (Mukharjee) and Miss Surabhi Mukharjee of Ramnangar Road No.4)

Pranita Banerjee (Mukharjee) and Miss Surabhi Mukharjee of Ramnangar Road No.4 (Last Station) having Contact No.8240575184/9007668045 against Sri Brijesh Pandey, Revenue Secretary In-Charge and against, Deputy Collector &amp; Magistrate, Dukli and Tehsilder, Badharghat.</p> <p>Allegation was that the petitioner filed a revenue case application along with condonation bearing No.4067/REV/24 and 4068/REV/24 in the month of June, 2024 and a reminder letter was also sent to the Chief Secretary, Government of Tripura on 26.08.2024 through DTDC and was received in the office of the Chief Secretary, Government of Tripura on 28.08.2024 and she made a prayer for taking appropriate step and giving necessary direction. 
dispute are Smt. Pramita Banerjee (Mukharjee) and another Miss Surabhi Mukharjee versus Smt. Charubala Debnath, wherein the Agartala Shri Shri Sai Baba Seva Mandir and Trust has interfered and acquired land through coercion and manipulation techniques under Touji No.335 where Khatian No.10304 is the first and primary Khatian in the name of Smt. Pramita Banerjee (Mukharjee) with land area measuring 1.36 acre which was struck off without hearing the concerned owner or her well-wishers, by the Tehsilder Badharghat and DCM, Dukli at their own will / wish and this act has been a continuous process even till now. The relevant authority did not list out the matter and passed any final order either before favouring or unfavouring inspite of being aware of the relevant facts and laws. They kept the matter pending without any admissible cause which discriminates the complainants access to justice and order. The complainant requested the authority to hear them, but the authority remained silent and as such authority is considered by the complainants to be negligent of their duty. The complainant sought for appropriate inquiry into the matter, to summon the Revenue Secretary Shri Brijesh Pandey,


  


Deputy Collector, Dukli and Tehsilder Badharghat for a hearing and to dispose of her dispute made in the application and to pass necessary recommendation as this Commission may deem fit and appropriate.

On perusal of the complaint, the Commission considers that this is a civil dispute between the two parties and the land issue does not come within the purview of fundamental rights or violation of human rights. As such the matter of the complaint is beyond the purview of the Commission and so the complaint is disposed of in limine. Inform the complainant accordingly.
