The allegation of the complainant shows that he is a day labourer and his unmarried sister Mst. Suhel Begam, who is a deaf & dumb person is totally dependent on him and he claims that he is unable to give the entire income to his wife and he prays to take necessary action from the end of this Commission.

The Commission examined the complaint. The complaint does not disclose any violation of his human rights either by a public servant or by the State Agencies. So, the Commission cannot take any cognizance in the matter mentioned in the complaint. Moreover, this Commission cannot take cognizance in matters which are subjudice before the Court of Law.

In view of Regulation of the Tripura Human Rights Commission Regulation-2022, the present complaint is liable to be dismissed.

Accordingly, no action can be taken on the complaint. Thus, the complaint is dismissed in limine.
