



03	02.12.24	<p>AIGP (Crime) for and on behalf of the DGP, Tripura has submitted a report inter alia stating that on 28.10.2024 at about 22:05 hrs one Surajit Biswas of West Laxmibill, PS Bishalgarh over phone informed the PS that some local people of Laxmibill area were creating disturbances in his house and misbehaved with him and his girlfriend and he sought police help and accordingly, WSI Jhuma Das with police staff went there and examined Surajit Biswas and his girlfriend Miss Sampa Bhowmik as well as some local people. It was found that Surajit Biswas and Sampa Bhowmik were in love affairs for about four years and they used to visit the house of each other. When Sampa Bhowmik was visiting the house of Surajit Biswas, on that day, local people gathered there and created nuisance and tried to arrange marriage between them.</p> <p>Police interfered on the issue and asked the local people about the legal position of the matter and they have rescued the girl and handed over to her legal guardian. Neither Surajit nor Sampa were inclined to lodge any complaint and to that effect Sampa had given a written declaration. However, after inquiry, police submitted a PR U/S 126 of</p>	


BNSS against six persons, which referred to Bishalgarh Women PS PR No. 324/24 dated 28.10.2024.

The report seems to be satisfactory and hence Commission does not like to proceed further on that matter. Accordingly, the inquiry initiated by the Commission is closed.
