

07	07.02.2025	<p>Pursuant to the order dated 10.01.2025 Mr. Ranjit Debbarma, MLA, Tripura Legislative Assembly is present.</p> <p>Sri Budhu Chandra Debbarma, son of the deceased has not appeared today. Mr. MLA submits that Budhu Ch. Debbarma is a minor one, aged about 16 years and as such he has brought Smt. Durpati Debbarma, wife of the deceased, for examination. But Smt. Durpati Debbarma, on examination, is found deaf and dumb and as such her statement cannot be recorded due to want of interpreter. Mr. MLA prays for an adjournment for 10 days to bring father-in-law of the deceased, namely, Sri Uttam Debbarma.</p> <p>This Commission today has examined on oath Mr. Ranjit Debbarma, MLA. Mr. MLA in his evidence claims that Dilip Debbarma, now deceased, is not the original name. The original name of the deceased is Bishurai Debbarma, S/O. Sukuncharan Debbarma and in support of this fact he has submitted a copy of the Adhaar Card. He has also submitted another copy of Adhaar Card in respect of Smt. Durpati Debbarma claiming that she is the wife of the deceased, but the</p>	

Adhaar Card does not bear the name of Bishurai Debbarma or Dilip Debbarma as the wife of the deceased.

Accordingly, Mr. MLA prays for arranging an investigation through this Commission. That matter will be taken up subsequently after examination of Sri Uttam Debbarma, father-in-law of the deceased.

Let the matter be fixed after a week for examination of Uttam Debbarma, father-in-law of the deceased.
