| 01     | 03.03.25 | <p>Received an e-mail complaint from one Anushree Roy of Durgapur, West Bengal, Dist.- Burdwan having e-mail ID- <a href="mailto:royanushri1993@gmail.com">royanushri1993@gmail.com</a> wherein she made a complaint that one individual namely: Paramananda Roy of Agartala, Dist.- West Tripura has entered into wedlock for the second time during the life time of his first wife and thus violated law of the land and she prays for taking necessary action.</p> <p>The complainant does not disclose the name of the first wife of Paramananda Roy. Even proper address of said Paramananda Roy is also not disclosed.</p> <p>However, registered the e-mail as a complaint. The Commission perused the complaint as it appears that the complainant lodged an allegation of bigamy which is punishable U/S 82 of BNS. Section 219 of BNS prevents a court to take cognizance of such offence accept upon a complaint made by some persons aggrieved by the offence.</p> <p>Thus the offence of bigamy cannot be investigated by police since it is not a cognizable offence. Moreover, this complaint does not show violation of human rights of the complainant by the State of Tripura or by any public</p> |      |

servant or by any Govt. officer.

Thus the matter is beyond the purview of Tripura Human Rights Commission.

Hence no action can be taken on the complaint of the complainant. The complaint petition is thus disposed of without any action.
