02	13/03/2025	<p>Today is fixed for report of the DGP Tripura in respect of allegation against the police action involving the incident as reported in the complaint of Ranjit Debbarma, MLA.</p> <p>Received a report from the O/o the DGP Tripura signed by Smt. Sarmistha Chakraborty, AIGP, (crime).</p> <p>Perused the report, the report shows that medical officer Dr. Rajat Goswami, Melaghar S.D hospital, Sepahijala, opined that the patient, namely, Bajanti Debbarma had a blunt trauma injury on her right thigh which was simple in nature inflicted by blunt object. The other highlighted portions of this report show that no NDPS contrband item was recovered from the house of accused person as well as from their possession and no NDPS case was registered against the FIR named accused persons. The O/C, Melaghar PS stated that on 20.12.2024, a police mobile visited Indra Kumar Para/taksa Para on receipt of information regarding death of Bajanti Debbarma at Cancer Center,</p>	


Agartala. The team visited when cremation of Bajanti Debbarma was going on. But no complaint was made by Basanta Debbarma regarding death of Bajanti Debbarma, in consequence of assault on her and, accordingly, Post-mortem examination over body of Bajanti Debbarma was not felt necessary. After receiving the complaint petition, O/C, Melaghar P.S submitted a prayer before Ld. court for allowing further investigation since the case was under trial . But the order of the court is yet to be received.

It is also mentioned in the report that as per Medical Prescription of Dr. Srihans Sipani dated 21.09.2024, it was revealed that Bajanti Debbarma was being treated for ovarian cyst and as per OPD registration No. 2204/24 dated 25.11.2024 of Atal Bihari Bhajpaye Regional Cancer Center, Agartala, Tripura, Bajanti Debbarma was diagnosed for ovarian malignant, wherein the history of assault upon bajanti Debbarma was not mentioned.

This being the position as revealed from the report of AIGP, (Crime), Tripura, the Commission considers that a copy of the report shall be given to the complainant and for his response, if any, against the report received from the office of the DGP, Tripura.

Accordingly, send a copy of the report of AIGP (crime) to the complainant asking him to submit his response, if any, against that report and fix the next date after one month.
