24	25.03.25	<p>Today received a report dated 18th March, 2025 from Labour Commissioner by which he encloses a reply from Register of Company, Guwahati. As per that document in the MCA Portal, no companies are registered under the companies Act, 1956/2013 in the name of Ranibari Tea Company Ltd. and Silkot Tea Company Ltd. Notingcherra Tea Estate and Debasthal Tea Estate are allegedly owned by Ranir Bari Tea Company Ltd. and Hiracherra Tea Estate is allegedly owned by Silkot Tea Company Ltd. It is already on record that there is no existence of Sonamukhi Tea Company Ltd. So it is clear that so far as Debasthal Tea Estate and Notingcherra Tea Estate are concerned, Ranibari Tea Company Ltd. cannot be considered as owner, since there is no existence of that company. Similarly Silkot Tea Company Ltd. is also not the owner of Hiracherra Tea Estate and that Company has got no existence.</p> <p>Pursuant to order dated 17.02.2025 Mr. Subhash Ch. Saha, Director Land Record & Settlement, Govt. of Tripura appears before the Commission and submits that on behalf of Land Record & Settlement Department, Govt. of Tripura a report has already been submitted on 24.02.2025</p>

addressed to the Labour Commissioner. He claimed that on previous occasion also the Land Record & Settlement Department already submitted their report to the Labour Commissioner but somehow it was misplaced.

On behalf of DM & Collector, Unakoti District Mr. Suraj Debbarma, Dy. Collector appears before this Commission and submits a report signed by the DM & Collector dated 21.03.2025 supplying copy thereof to the Labour Commissioner. Also received another communication from Revenue Department copy to labour Commissioner. Since Labour Commissioner already received copies of those reports from those departments, the Labour Commissioner shall file his comments on those reports by the next date.

This being the position, except Labour Department, other departments should not take steps further in this case. On perusal of the report of DM & Collector, Unakoti District, it appears that no report has been submitted in respect of Debasthal Tea Estate.

However, Labour Department is to submit their comments in consultation with DM & Collector, Revenue Department and Land Records & Settlement taking in view of the report of Register of Company, Guwahati.
