		by one Shegun Miah S/O Jalil Miah along with PWD main	
	,	road and that shop has been creating significant disturbance	
		which had led to several issues in the area. Commission	
	1	does not find any violation of human rights on that fact.	
	lu	Furthermore, it is mentioned in the complaint that the	
		villagers have previously filed complaints before SDM,	

Udaipur regarding that matter and following the complaints SDM, Udaipur also issued an official order for the closure of the shop and took appropriate action by dismantling it. Despite of that order, the shop owner, Shegun Miah continued to operate his shop illegally showing defiance and disrespect to the Govt. orders. Moreover, the shop owner with the support of some other people has been creating a tense atmosphere and creates a communal instability in their peaceful locality. This situation has created tension and also disrupts the communal harmony. Thus the complainants without disclosing their names request the Commission to take action against Shegun Miah for violation of the Govt. orders. Some documents are also attached with the complaint petition. Among those documents there is a memo dated 27.01.2025 issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Udaipur which show that SDM, Udaipur has formed a team with some revenue officials with direction to submit a detail report to him after completion of the said work. The complainants failed to show any documents that the said Shegun Miah has violated any order of the SDM or Govt. authorities.

The complaint does not show that right of the unknown complainants have been violated by the Govt. or by public servant or by any Govt. offices or agencies and as such the present complaint does not come within the purview of this Commission. Moreover, under the regulations of Tripura Human Rights Commission, the Commission cannot take cognizance on a complaint of some persons who did not



disclose their names.

In view of this matter the Commission considers that no inquiry need be setup on the basis of the complaint since the subject matter of the complaint is beyond the purview of this Commission.

Hence this complaint is disposed of without any inquiry.
