Secretary, Revenue Department, Director of Land Records and Settlement, Representative of DM &amp; Collector, Unakoti and Labour Officer, Unakoti District to determine the owner of the four Tea Estate and minutes of the meeting is enclosed to this Commission.</p> <p>Perused the report.</p> <p>As per the minutes, Labour Department will communicate with the concerned police authorities of Karimganj, Assam and West Bengal in order to find out where about of the owner of Hiracherra, Notingcherra and Debasthal Tea Estate situated at Unakoti District, Kailashahar, Tripura.</p> <p>Addl. Commissioner, Labour Department is also physically present. The main priority of this Commission is to see how the human rights of the labourer can be protected. 
to see who are the owners of those Tea Estates. It is clear that Department of Labour is responsible to protect the rights and interest of the labourers of those Tea Estate.
