01	27/06/2025	<p>Received a complaint from one Benu Paul, S/o Lt. Bhanwary Paul of Kathal Bagan, opposite of B.Ed College, Agartala under NCC P.S, having mobile No. 7005853575, where in the complainant mentioned that he was running a business on rent in the house of Lt. Subhash Sinha and the house is now owned by his wife Smt. Neela Sinha, Gurkhabasti, Kathal Bagan. He entered into an agreement in the year 2021, but that agreement expired on 31.07.2024. According to him, Smt. Neela Sinha, without giving any intimation to him engaged the Officer in charge and second officer of NCC P.S for his eviction. Accordingly, O/C and 2nd officer of NCC P.S visited his shop-hut and threatened him to close the shop.</p> <p>It is alleged that on 25.06.2025 in the afternoon, the 2nd officer of the NCC P.S came and abused the wife of the complainant in a dirty language and threatened her to vacate the shop hut within 24 hours; otherwise, they should be ready for dire consequences.</p> <p>According to the complainant, he kept Rs. 5000/- as a security to Smt. Neela Sinha. The money receipt of the security deposit was not issued by the owner.</p> <p>According to the complainant, the shop hut is his only source of income and presently he is staying in a rented house with his wife and daughter. The complainant prays for due action against those police</p>	

officers since his human rights have been violated by them and he also prays to allow him some more time to search for a new shop premises.

When the Commission is considering the incident, suddenly one telephone call came in the mobile of the complainant's mobile No. 7005853757 from a mobile No. 7005052184.

The complainant submitted that from O/C, NCC called him and asked him to appear before him at NCC P.S immediately without any loss of time and threatened him for violation of his direction.

Considering the gravity of the circumstances, the Commission deems it fit to take cognizance of the case. Accordingly, cognizance is taken.

Send a copy of the complaint to the DGP, Tripura, with a direction to submit a report after due inquiry regarding the complaint made in the allegation and list the case after 15 days.

Fix it on 18/07/25 for report of DGP.
