01	02.07.25	<p>Attention of the Commission is drawn to a news item published in daily newspaper 'Tripura Times' dated 2nd July, 2025 Issue No. 253 under the heading "Alleged ragging forces student to leave JNV hostel in Khowai".</p> <p>Perused the news item.</p> <p>It is reported that that a serious allegation of ragging has been reported from Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in Khowai, Ramchandraghat. A student of class IX, Ayush Dutta, fled from the school hostel on Saturday, unable to endure the ongoing ragging by senior students. He later returned to his home in the Sepahihowar area of Khowai. On Monday, Ayush and his parents lodged a formal complaint at Khowai Police Station, alleging mental and physical harassment by senior students.</p> <p>Student claimed that he was frequently forced to obey unreasonable instructions from seniors and was subjected to physical punishment if he resisted. Unable to cope, he took the drastic step of escaping the residential campus. In response of his sudden disappearance, the school authorities filed a missing dairy to the local police force, by then the student already reached home safely and informed his family about the alleged abuse. It is that the school</p>	

authorities have not yet issue a formal statement or confirmed any disciplinary action as of the time of that report.

On perusal of the news item, Commission thinks it appropriate to direct the DGP, Tripura, the DM & Collector, Khowai District and Principal, JNV, Khowai to submit their response as to be news item.

Report of the above mentioned authorities should reach this Commission within 15 days.
