12	21/07/2025	<p>Today is fixed for compliance report by the DGP, Tripura, in respect of final order dated 29.01.2025.</p> <p>Received a report from the office of the DGP, Tripura, dated 19.07.2025 signed by AIGP (Crime).</p> <p>As per report, pursuant to the final order, a compensation of Rs. 25,000/- has been paid to the complainant Samir Sinha by deducting the amount from the salary of the inspector, Sri Sukanta Sen Chowdhury.</p> <p>From the report, it also appears that a disciplinary proceeding has already been drawn and memorandum of article charges were also framed against Sri Sukanta Sen Chowdhury, O/C Kailasahar P.S, under rule 14 of CCS(CCA) Rules 1965. In addition as per other recommendations, the matter was referred to the SP Unakoti for strict compliance and in reply the SP, Unakoti directed the SDM Kailasahar to take steps sensitize the police officers of Kailashahar P.S and to give information to the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal after every road traffic accident is registered. The SDPO was also directed to arrange sensitization workshop for all the P.S in Kailasahar Sub-Division.</p> <p>This being the position, it is clear that the majority of the recommendations, such as making payment of compensation of Rs. 25,000/- and drawing of DP against the default police personnel</p>	

have been complied with and in respect of other recommendations also, necessary direction was given to the concerned police authorities to sensitize the P.S personnel of the Koilashahar, Sub-Division.

So, the Commission is satisfied that the recommendations of the Commission have been duly complied with. So, the matter be published in our website and accordingly, this case is thus closed.
