Thereafter the incident came to the knowledge of the concerned hostel Superintendent and guardians of both Kishan Debbarma and Langma Debbarma as well as school authorities. It was informed that Hon'ble Minister of Tribal Welfare Sri Bikash Debbarma receiving the information about the incident also visited Umakanta Academy ST Boy's Hostel on 29/06/2025 to assess the situation and the matter was also immediately informed to the Officer In-Charge of West Agartala Police Station for taking necessary action as per law.

On 30/06/2025 at about 03:30 PM, a meeting was held in the chamber of the Principal of Umakanta Academy Bengali Medium, Agartala which were chaired by the local Councilor Smt. Jahanabi Das Choudhury in present of School Management Committee, hostel Superintendent, boarders along with guardians and Sri Ballin Debbarma, Extension Officer (TW) as representative of SDM office, Sadar. The matter regarding the incident of quarrel amongst the boarders of Umakanta Academy ST Boys Hostel were briefly discussed in the said meeting and it was decided in the meeting by way of resolution that the boarders namely Nueal Kaipeng and Kear Jamatia both are found guilty of misconduct and were temporarily expelled from the hostel for 15 (fifteen) days. However, they were allowed to attend their school.

As per report, presently, both Nueal Kaipeng and Kear Jamatiaare disqualified and removed from the hostel as a disciplinary action taken by the hostel authorities. But in the report, it was mentioned that there was no incident of ragging in the Umakanta ST Boys hostel attached to Umakanta Academy Bengali Medium, Agartala. It is clear that it was mere a fight incident amongst the above mentioned boarders which happened on 27.06.2025 midnight.

On perusal of the report of the DM & Collector, West Tripura confusion cropped up since in the beginning it was mentioned that both Nueal Kaipent and Kear Jamatia was started abusing, slapping and physically assaulting both the Langma Debbarma and Kishan Debbarma without any previous fight, argument and any kind of altercation. Then how the DM & Collector can term the incident as merely fight between 2(two) groups of students.

This being the position, the Commission thinks it appropriate to direct the Investigation Wing of this Commission to have an inquiry in this matter and to submit a detailed report before this Commission by the next date and accordingly, fix the next date after 3 weeks for report of the Investigation Wing.
