02.	27/08/2025	Today is fixed for report of the D.M. & Collector, Khowai District, Supdt. of Police, Khowai, Director, Fire & Emergency Services, Govt. of Tripura, in respect of a tragic incident reported in different newspapers of Tripura on 06/08/2025 specially in Dainik Sambad under the caption “প্রশাসনিক ব্যর্থতার বেআরু চেহারা দেখলো রাজ্যবাসী”. Received a report from the D.M. & Collector. In that report, D.M. & Collector basically mentioned that the tragic incident at Chakmaghat was not disaster in formal sense but rather a lone road traffic accident involving a single vehicle. Such incident fall under the category of emergency response rather than disaster response. The primary response agency is always Fire & Emergency Services Department rather than the Disaster Management team. The accident nevertheless presented an extremely challenging rescue scenario that required	

	unprecedented co-ordination among multiple departments and demonstrated the unwavering commitment of Tripura's Civil Administration and associated response mechanisms for preserving human life. The narratives that the victims was left un aided or that the District Administration or any responding authority was negligent or insensitive is entirely unsubstantiated by factual events and eye witnesses accounts formal departments present. Every conceivable effort was made under extremely difficult circumstances to save the victim. The unfortunate loss of life was due to the severities of physical entrapment and injuries sustained for the impact, not from a lack of response or co-ordination. The District Administration remains fully committed to uphold Human Rights and taking all systematic lessons from this sad incidence to further strengthening training, SOPs, and equipment availability for future.	
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Also received another report from Supdt. of Police, Khowai through the office of the DGP, Tripura and in that report SP has mentioned about the action taken by police. Keep the same with the record. Another communication is received from the Director, Fire & Emergency Services praying for

10(ten) days more time to submit a report. So, fix the next date after 3(three) weeks for report of the Director, Fire & Emergency Services, Tripura.
