places selecting the needs for installation of the divider on the road are mainly within the domain of the appropriate authority of the Government. The said authorities have requisite expertise in the field, which the Commission has not.

In view of this, I find no merit in the complaint and Human Rights Commission cannot step in to take cognizance of the complaint that the complainants have tried to agitate before this Commission.

They may approach the appropriate Government authority for their redress.

Accordingly, the complaint lodged by the complainants is dropped without taking any cognizance.
